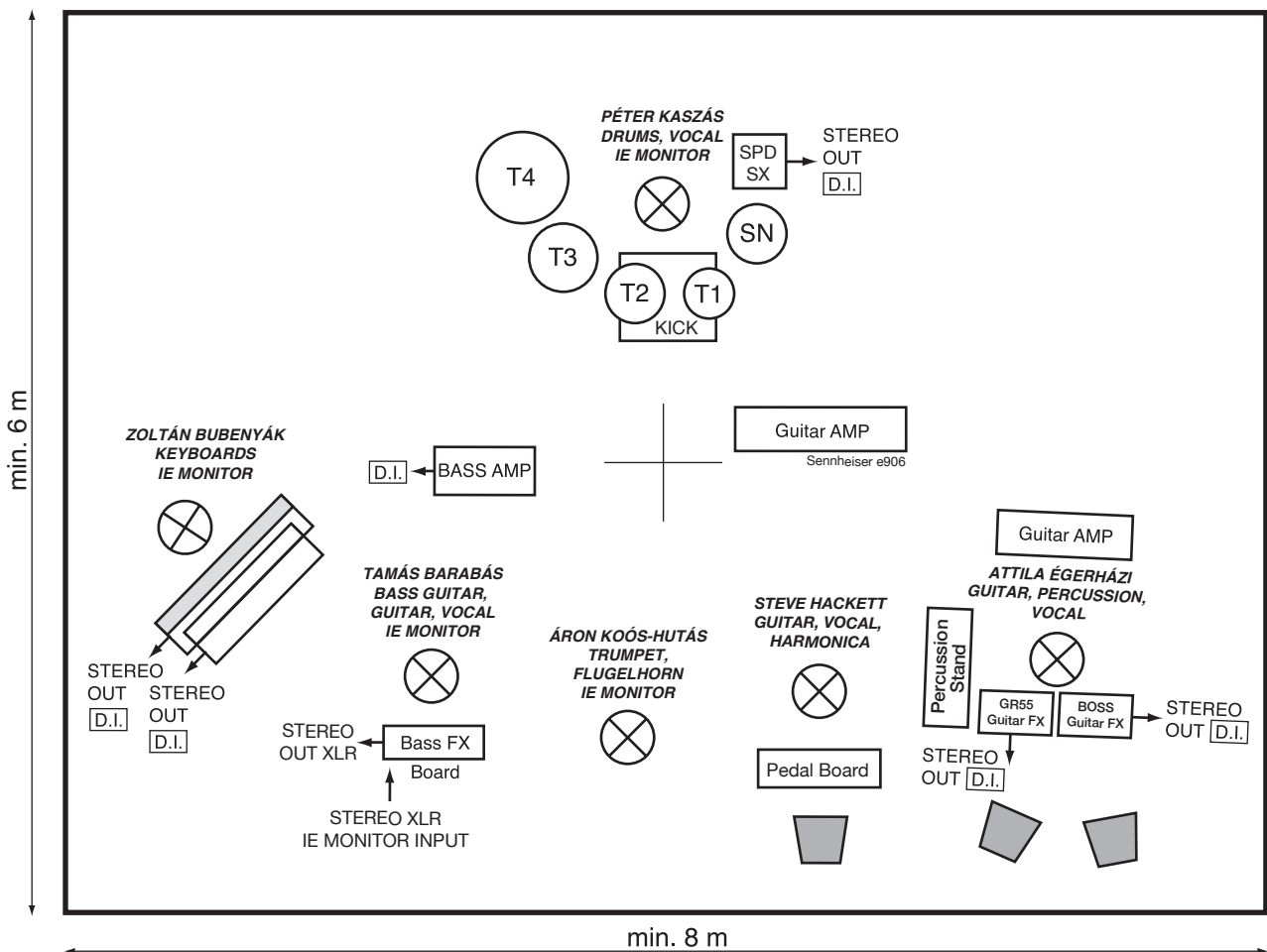
Soundsystem: Professional P.A. system (e.g.: Meyersound, Martin- Audio, d&b audiotechnic, JBL (no jrx, tr, sp, eon), L'Acoustic. installed, phase and frequency alligned perfectly- 100dBA LAeq at mix position, 30-12kHz +/- 3dB unweighted freq response. Monitors are preferably 15" (or 2x12"), bi-amped and all wedges are the same! with required amp and processing (LE1500, M2, M4, PS15). The IEMs are travelling with the Band.

F.O.H.: The Band is on tour with own Console, please provide 3 pcs CAT5e or CAT6 cable from stage to F.O.H. or cablecross and hands to set-up and dismantle our own. Position is in the middle of audience, floorlevel. If there is no ANY chance to use our own console we accept All kind of professional mixers (**prefered Allen and Heath SQ6 or DLive S series**, Digico SD7/8/10, Yamaha CL5, Avid S6L, Soundcraft Vi, Midas Pro /NO Midas M32 or Behringer X32 please), please patch it before the band arrives.

Monitors are driven from the F.O.H. – we need 7 more returns above the PA, TB, ect.

Stands, looms, di, cables- please use equipments in good condition, and select thees items from well-known manufacturers (k&m, klotz, Radial Di-s preferred), 18 chanel loom at the back and 14 chanel break-out in the front

-please don't use low quality equipments-



Stage:

Size: 10x12 m, (minimum 6x8 m), non skidding, full factoryproduct stage with stairs (white line border mark, lighs), railngs and TUV certificate is the only acceptabel way. If it is an outdoor event it should be a covered stage. The roofing should meet the European CE and TUV certification and lows.

Stagehands, Technicians:

Please provide 2 sober load in/out guys for the backline.
Please provide min. one stagehand for microphoning and cabeling, 1 lightoperator, 1 F.O.H. Babysitter.
The monitors are driven from F.O.H.

Soundcheck, load-in:

The stage must be ready for the setup based on the rider 30 minutes before the contracted load in time.
The set-up takes two hours, Artist require two hours for the sondcheck.
